

## Transcultural Community Camp (TCC) Groups, Leadership and Social Transformation

A 3-day international group work experience that aims at enhancing the transcultural understanding of the self, the other, the institution and the community.

Using indoor and outdoor activities within a safe environment, participants will get the opportunity to learn, choose, act and reflect. The camp is inspired by the Egyptian culture and history, nourished and enriched by the international diversity. Small and large group activities and interactions, including different tasks that target the common objectives, will help the discovery of the broader dimensions of groups, leaderships and social transformations. Responsibilities, creativity and productivity are the foundation of the camp.

### Participants will get the chance to:

- Recognize the power of the group in a broader context.
- Discover new resources in oneself and others.
- Reflect on the prospect of conducting groups.
- Acquire a new perspective, experience and orientation to leadership.
- Acknowledge the challenges to group work, leadership and social transformation.

### Attendance:

The camp is offered for counselors, managers, individuals and organization consultants, mental health professionals, trainers, educators and individuals working in groups. Understanding and speaking English is required (not necessarily fluent).

**Attending the whole three days, with no missing hours or days, is a necessity to be able to receive a certificate of attendance.**
