Following the success of the 2018 camp, it is our pleasure to announce for the upcoming 2020 Transcultural Community Camp, from 11 to 13 January. It is a 3-day international group work experience that aims at enhancing the transcultural understanding of the self, the other, the institution and the community.



Using indoor and outdoor activities within a safe environment, participants will get the chance to learn, choose, act and reflect. The camp is inspired by the Egyptian culture and history, nourished and enriched by the international diversity. Group interactions and experiences will offer opportunities for discovering broader dimensions of groups, leaderships and social transformations.



By the end of the camp, participants will get chance to:

- Recognize the power of the group in a broader transcultural context
- Reflect on the prospect of conducting group work
- Get a new perspective, experience and orientation to leadership
- Discover new resources in oneself and others in light of positive social transformation
- Acknowledging the challenges to group work, leadership and social transformation



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Attendance:

The camp is offered for counselors, managers, consultants, mental health professionals, trainers, educators as well as individuals working in group settings. Preference will be given to younger professionals. Understanding and speaking English is required (not necessarily fluent).

Attending the whole three days, with no missing hours or days, is a necessity. By the end of the camp, the participants will get a certificate of attendance.

The Daily Schedule:

It is a three-day-group work that starts on Saturday January 11th at 9:00am and ends on Monday 13th 2018 at 6:00pm. The time schedule is structured on the basis of small and large group activities that, at times, include different tasks, but always target the common objectives. Time and space will be dedicated for reflection on the process, the learning experience, and the individual's position within the camp frame.

Members will participate in diverse activities, with a special emphasis on equal responsibilities, creativity and productivity along the different camp activities.
